

Rules on the Farm

For your safety and for the protection of the land, farm animals and crops, we ask that you read all the rules and guidelines listed below.

1. Please observe and follow ALL notices and signs. For the safety of the farm, please drive SLOWLY. Please observe this as you enter and exit the farm. Please watch for children, ducks, and chickens.
2. Absolutely NO THROWING of anything is allowed. Fruit, vegetables, rocks, sticks, etc.
3. Dogs are NOT allowed to come on the farm at all. Please do not bring your dog for tours... We have a Field Guardian Donkey, who will not appreciate it!
4. NO organized, unreserved group picnics are allowed on the farm. Organized visits require reservations. For information on our reserved classes feel free to email us to make a reservation at kenya@realmilklexington.com.
5. Do Not Park on our road unless you pull all the way into the grass. You are at risk of being hit by passing vehicles and cyclist. Cars parked on the street will be asked to relocate your vehicle promptly. There is ample parking on the farm, simply enter the driveway park in the front or back of the house.
6. We do not accept large groups or Commercial Busses.
7. Please do not bring food from home for the farm animals. They are on a strict, nutritional diet.
8. Absolutely no smoking is allowed on the farm! Anyone smoking will be asked to extinguish their cigarette and asked to leave.
9. To make this a fun & educational experience for all, we ask that you please WATCH, MAINTAIN & CONTROL your children.
10. Please be careful when walking in our fields. Our crops are fragile and need to be treated with respect, the land is uneven and often muddy too.
11. Wear appropriate shoes and kindly wipe your shoes off prior to entering structures. If very muddy, it may be appropriate to remove your shoes.
12. ANIMALS ARE AT LARGE on the property at all times. Under no circumstances are any persons permitted in the fields without a farm representative.
13. No swimming or fishing is permitted in the creek.
14. When you are in the fields on a tour, feel free to sample our crops. But please DO NOT step on the vegetable plants.
15. This is NOT a pick-your-own farm.
16. We do not sell meat or dairy . Ask us for more info, we are happy to direct you on how to legally get your raw milk.
17. No hunting of any kind is permitted and this includes bow hunting.
18. Please do not ask if you can bring your dirt bikes to ride up and down our pastures. We do not permit this activity.
19. DO NOT open any farm gates. Do not jump over fences or gates.
20. Please be aware and keep well away from tractors and farm machinery. This is a working farm and Farm Equipment is not a toy.

21. Please be kind and courteous to your fellow visitors and members of our team and volunteers
22. Please listen to the members of our staff and know that they are working very hard to make sure your time at the farm is a memorable one but also a safe experience.
23. Be a Gentle Visitor and ask permission prior to taking pictures. No photography inside any structure on the property is permitted. Pictures are welcome and encouraged outside. Thank you for your understanding
24. This is not a PETTING ZOO. We ask that you respect our animals. If you are ever permitted to pet them please wash your hands before and after
25. Please do not Litter. There are large trash cans on the entrance of the barn.
26. Bathrooms are for farm staff only. *Please ask for assistance and we will show you to the restroom.
27. No drugs, profanity or persons under the influence. Disruptive individuals will be asked to leave.
28. We reserve the right to deny entrance.
29. When the Black Iron Entrance Gates are closed, we are more than likely closing it for animal traffic. If there is a "Closed" sign on the gates then we are CLOSED. The farm is only open for appointments only. To a very limited group of members. Please plan your visit according to our schedule of classes and tours. If you need to reschedule please call or text and we will do our best to accommodate you.
30. The farm is not open for scheduled tours during the winter, however, we will do our best to accommodate you just give us a call.
31. Kindly ask permission if in doubt.
32. ** Take your time in the countryside and enjoy your farm visit! **
